

## **PRECOURSE WORK**

Participants are required to complete one (1) web-based prerequisite course prior to attending the three day instructor-led Plan Review for Food Establishments course. The purpose of the web-based prerequisite course is to introduce participants to key concepts and terminology of basic plumbing and cross connection control. The instructor led modules and lessons will build upon the concepts and content presented during the prerequisite web-based course.

### ***Plumbing Controls for Commercial Food Establishments***

This course can be accessed in two ways:

1. **FDA Employees:** This course is available in DHRD's LMS Pathlore system as *CC8001W: Plumbing Controls for Commercial Food Establishments*. FDA employees can sign into Pathlore, search for "CC8001W," register and complete the course.
2. **Non-FDA Government Employees:** State, local, tribal and military employees may access this course at DHRD's LMS Pathlore system as *CC8001W: Plumbing Controls for Commercial Food Establishments*. Participants must request an account if not already created, sign into Pathlore, search for "CC8001W," register and complete the course.
3. **Non-Government Employees:** Industry, academia, and other non-government employees may access this course at the Institute for Food Protection and Training Institute (IFPTI) by registering at <https://ifpti.absorbtraining.com/#/login> and purchase the course, *FDA - Plumbing Controls for Commercial Food Establishments*. There may be a fee to access the course.

Additionally, participants are encouraged to attend one of the following instructor-led course or series web based prerequisite courses prior to attending the three day instructor led Plan Review for Food Establishments course:

- FD112 Food Code, or
- FDAFC01 – FDAFC11 Food Code online series, and read the current Summary of Changes In the FDA Food Code

The purpose of the Food Code prerequisite course is to familiarize participants with the current version of the Food Code.
